The Urban Partnership Coalition, a partnership of Center for Reconciliation and Social Change, Inc. (**CRSC**) a *faith based community outreach*. Developed Nehemiah Community Pathfinder; series of illustrations, tools, paths that reference possible processes Nehemiah used to rebuild the walls in his community. A servant of the king, Nehemiah cried out for his people” seeking the kings’ support to re-build the walls. Even after getting the needed resources, Nehemiah had to **motivate** the people **to work** at **re-building**, then **maintaining the walls** that would protected them and their families.

The wall is a reference to six PATHWAYS by which families can be built upon; 1) Self Esteem, 2) Relationships, 3) Household Resources, Organization, 4) Community Resources, 5) Budget and Finance and 6) Time Management.

CRSC seeks to encourage families, faith & community organizations that espouse family values to join us at discovering four core values that encourage family (1) Promoting Strengthening Family and Youth; (2) Promote Awareness Family and Youth Programs, participation within the broaders their community; (3) Encouragement of a positive self-image and understanding among Family Unit; (Parents); Father & Mother, or (Single Parents) Father’s or Mothers & (Children) Youth, (4) Addressing priorities, needs or interest identified by **CRSC** Urban Partnership Coalition.

2010-2011 Priorities

Areas of interest for the 2010-2011 in the order of highest priority:

1. Strengthening The Family (budgeting, home organization, time management)
2. Support of Children; Waiting Youth (Foster Care, Orphaned or Waiting Children)
3. Youth Development;
Child Development (any stages of life), Integrity Building, Citizenship,
4. Parenting, Strengthening Relationships (any member of unit)
5. Motherhood; Single Parent Skills Development
6. Fatherhood; Single Parent Skills Development
