#### NEHEMIAH COMMUNITY PARTNERSHIP

The Nehemiah Community Partnership is the reference to the biblical process were Nehemiah, “a servant of the kings cried out for his people” seeking the kings support to re-build the walls’ Even after getting the resources, Nehemiah had to ***motivate*** the people ***to work*** at ***re-building***, then ***maintaining the walls*** that would protected them and their families.

The wall or the fence represents the six post; foundations by which families must build on; 1) Self Esteem, 2) Relationships, 3) Household Resources, Organization, 4) Community Resources, 5) Budget and Finance and 6) Time Management.

The Center for Reconciliation and Social Change, Inc, (***CRSC***) seeks to encourage faith and community organizations that may espouse family to join us in support of the family; ***(1)*** Programs that benefit Strengthening Family and Youth; ***(2)*** Promote Awareness of Strengthening Family and Youth, within the broaders their community; ***(3)*** Encouragement of a positive self-image and understanding among Family Unit; (Parents); Father & Mother, or Single Parents- Father’s or Mothers; Youth (Children) and or ***(4)*** address priority, needs or interest identified by Center for Reconciliation & Social Change Partners in the promotion of family.

#### 2008-2009Funding Priorities

Priority areas of interest for the 2008-2009 in the order of highest priority:

1. Strengthening The Family (budgeting, home organization, time management)
2. Support of Children; Waiting Youth (Foster Care, Orphaned or Waiting Children)
3. Youth Development;  
Child Development (any stages of life), Integrity Building, Citizenship,
4. Parenting, Strengthening Relationships (any member of unit)
5. Motherhood; Single Parent Skills Development
6. Fatherhood; Single Parent Skills Development
